



INSTALLATION-Pastor Hahn is planning an extra special installation for Pastor Norman Schmook on Sunday, July 26th at 9AM.

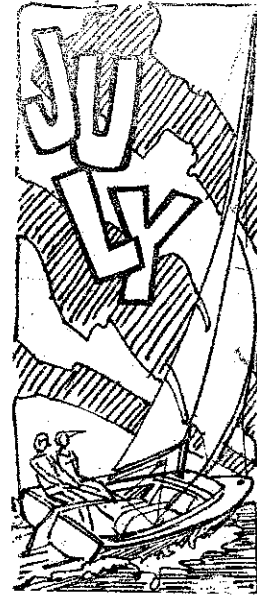
There will be a pot luck dinner following the service, so dig out your very best recipe for this special occasion.

LWML CONVENTION-MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN

MaryAnn Campbell, Karen Ecker, and Elaine Stroncek, along with Pastor and Mrs. Hahn, had the privilege of attending the LWML International Convention in Milwaukee June 22nd. 9500 attended the opening Communion Service held in the Milwaukee Arena. The offering, designated for the Mission Project goal, totaled \$18,016.14.

Rev. Dr. Guido Merkens, LCMS second vice president, emphasized the word "mission" in LWML. "Our number one task in the Church is to be in mission for Christ-- to invite people to "Come to the Living Waters!"

Dr. J.A.O. Preus, LCMS president, told the LWML in his address that "Women are a great force and factor in the church, not just for raising money or raising children, although that's important, but for carrying out the mission of the Lord. The age of women in the church is dawning, predicting a great and wonderful era."

Over 15,000 layettes for Lutheran World Relief were brought to the convention, five of them from Concordia. They were carried to a live manger scene as guests sang Christmas carols.

Mission project goal of \$650,000 was adopted by convention delegates.

Extra added attractions, including a visit to the Church where Pastor Hahn was confirmed, rounded out the trip. Time was also taken to visit Seward, Neb., and Concordia Teacher's College, as well as St. John's Lutheran Church. MaryAnn and Elaine's visit to Bethesda Lutheran Home in Watertown, Wisconsin, was a learning experience. Talk to any one of the ladies--they'll be glad to tell you about it.
