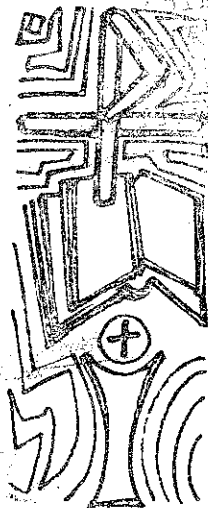

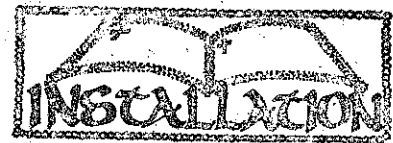
SATURDAY WORSHIP OPPORTUNITY...

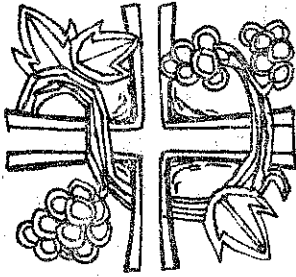
NEW OFFICERS...

Greetings in this New Year of 1931! The Lord has been good to us and we can look forward to his continued blessings in the future. For us as individuals, and for us as a congregation, we have every reason to rejoice and celebrate. It's exciting to think what God has in store for us this year. As Paul

wrote to the Corinthians (2 Cor. 1:19): "Jesus is God's 'Yes' for us. He is he who is the 'Yes' to all God's promises. This is why through Jesus Christ our 'Amen' is said to the glory of God. It is God himself who makes us, together with you, sure of our life in union with Christ; it is God himself who has set us apart, who has placed his mark of ownership upon us, and who has given us the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the guarantee of all that he has in store for us."

Some other thoughts:

+ Scheduling two services for Christmas Eve seemed to meet a need in the congregation and in the community. We had a total attendance of 190 (96 early, 94 late), as compared to 105 last year. The early service was about 75% visitors, and the late one was about 75% members. 44 worshiped on Christmas morning. I also counted about 120 in attendance at the Sunday School service. + With the beginning of our Saturday evening services, I hope families will not forget the extreme importance of Sunday School on Sunday morning. It would be easy to neglect this vital part of our Christian growth. Remember, adults have an opportunity to study and learn on Sunday mornings, too!

+ Roe and I are very grateful for the generous Christmas gift given to us at the Christmas Party. We have really appreciated your warmth, acceptance and generosity since we have been here. It has made these six months very happy months for us. From both of us, thank you--and happy new year!

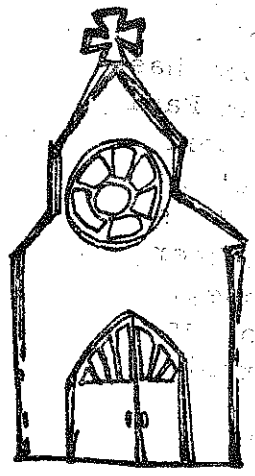

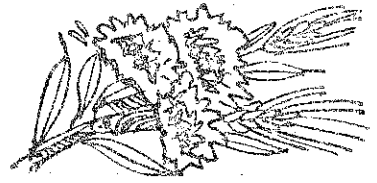

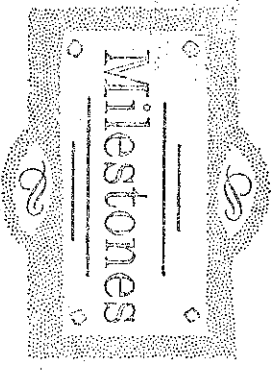
