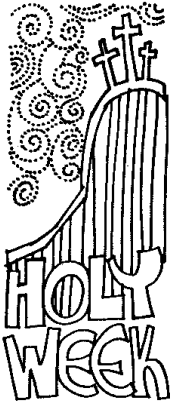

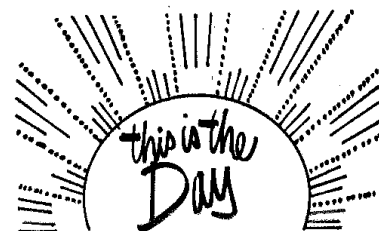

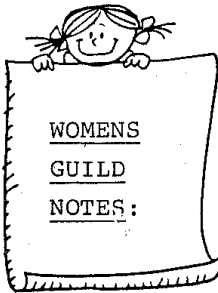


CLEANING SCHEDULE...
