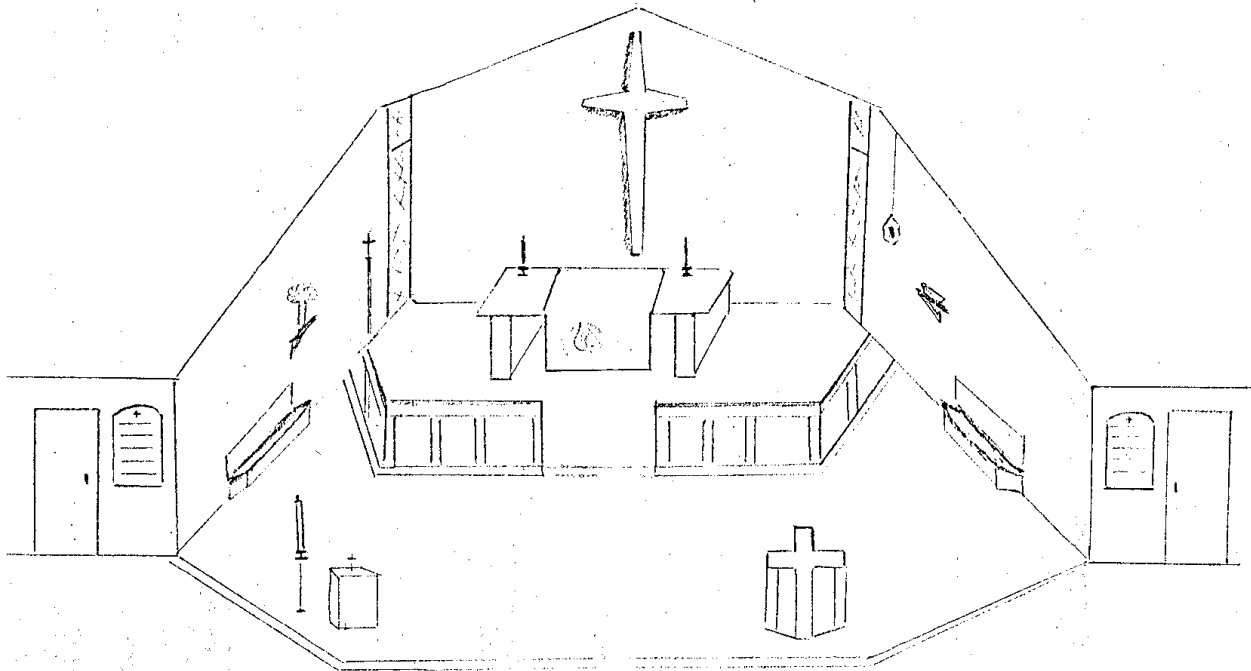

## FROM THE INTERIOR COMMITTEE...

The Interior Committee has distributed the booklet "As We Grow" to members within the past few weeks, informing them of items needed for the interior of our new church. Members and friends of the congregation are asked to prayerfully consider how they can help with donated items--as gifts or as memorials--over and above their regular contributions. Anyone having questions about specific items can talk to Pastor or Roe Schmoock.

The above drawing (a rough sketch--not intended to be an exact representation) depicts the worship area as planned by the Interior Committee, with the help of designer Don Hagemann of Kansas City. The pulpit/lectern, baptismal font, wall cross, and hymnboard from the present church will be stripped, retained a darker color, and used in the new church as shown. Items to be built (by Lou Volberding) include the free-standing altar, communion rail, and side shelves for vases and offering plates. Stained glass windows (on the sides of the altar area) and a new altar parament will be purchased

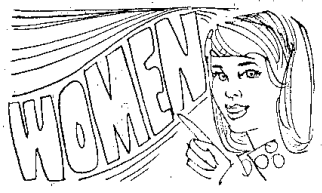

I have never known a generous family that was not generally happy.

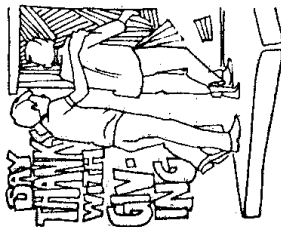
I have never known a stingy, miserly family that was not generally unhappy about many things.

CLOTHING BANK...

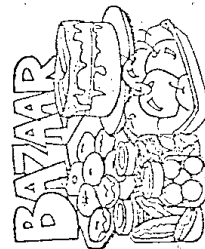
Do you have some clothing that you no longer use? Have you considered donating it to the local churches' Clothing Bank?

BAZAAR IS COMING...

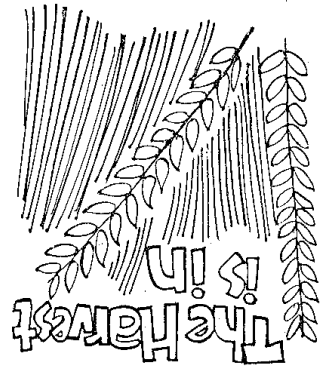
Concordia's Christmas Cupboard will be on December 7 this year. How are you coming with your craft items? If you have questions, call Sher Scheiwe!
