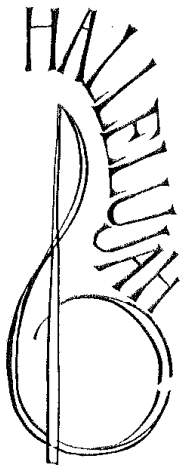

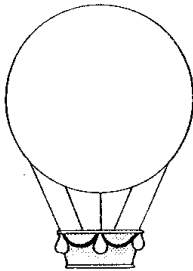

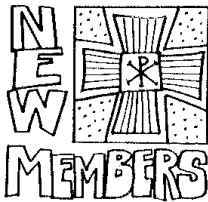

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY . . .

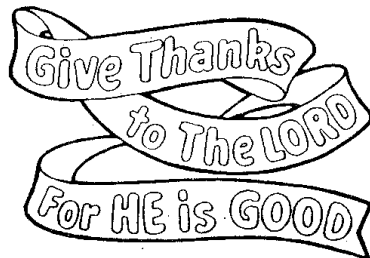

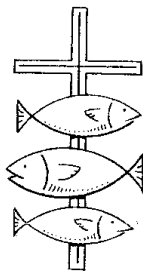

for personal reasons. We thank Ed for his faithful service while an Elder. Fritz Upham has been appointed to serve as Elder for the rest of the term.

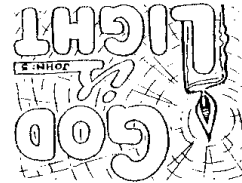
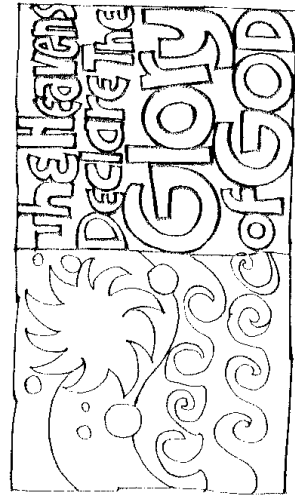
-- We pray God's continued blessings upon Laura McKelvie and Andrew Schmoock as they recuperate from surgeries this summer.
