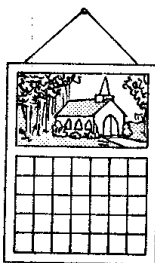


The 7th and 8th grade Sunday School Class is collecting Betty Crocker Coupons for a worthy cause. If you can donate any, please give them to class members or

Money from the Concordia Guild's Christmas Cupboard is going toward the finishing of the church library in the basement. Look for it to be completed within a month or so!

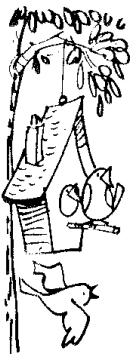

FIVE AFFIRMATIONS OF EASTER...

"The Lord is risen!" "He is risen indeed!" With those words we greet one another on Easter morning and throughout the Easter Season. The grave could not hold Jesus after He died on the cross to pay for our sins. The angel at the tomb met the bewildered women with the words, "Don't be afraid. You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. But go, tell His disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see Him, just as He told you'" (Mark16:6-7).

Last year, G. Roger Schoenhals wrote an article entitled, "Five Affirmations of Easter" (Lutheran Witness, April 1987). I condensed his thoughts for you here to help in your Easter celebration.

1) HE LIVES! The angel begins at the point of the women's experience, "You are looking for Jesus...He is not here." But with the obvious, he proclaims the Easter message for the first time, "He has risen!" Three historical words that form the foundation of our faith. And because Jesus lives, WE live. We have forgiveness, his presence, and his power to help us win our daily battles against temptation.

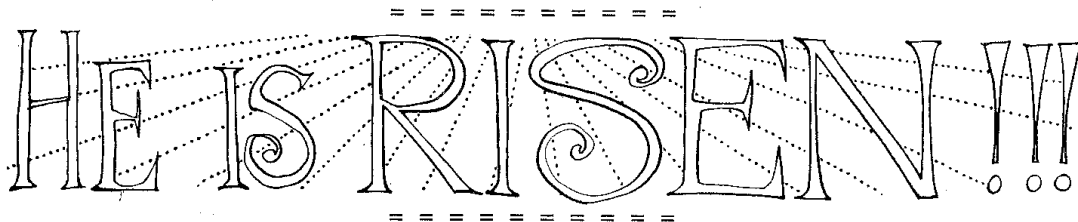
2) HE REVEALS HIMSELF! The angel said the disciples would see Jesus in Galilee. He would reveal himself to them, and WE can know him, too. Just as Jesus revealed himself to Mary Magdalene, the disciples and his followers, so he reveals himself to us. Our risen Lord is not hiding. Easter means we can know Jesus as our personal Savior and Lord.

3) HE KEEPS HIS WORD! Jesus said he would be crucified and buried and then rise on the third day. When he rose from the dead, he proved that he could be trusted. Easter affirms the faithfulness of God. WE can trust his promises! God will never let you down. "Just as he told you."

4) HE SENDS US OUT! The angel said, "Go, tell!" He gave the women a mission to spread the good news. We express our belief in the Resurrection not only with our hearts, but also with our feet. WE are witness to his resurrection!

5) HE GOES BEFORE US! Jesus never sends us out alone. Jesus is always "going ahead of you" to lead you. The empty tomb means we can have confidence in the future. When tomorrow comes, Jesus will already be there. When troubles come, Jesus knows about them beforehand. WE serve a risen Lord who will lead us safely home.

-Remember to write not only for the average person-in-the-pew, but also for the average person not-very-often-in-the-pew.

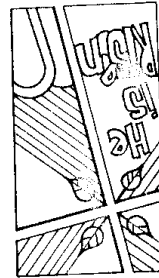
-Ask yourself if you'd like to read what you've written.
