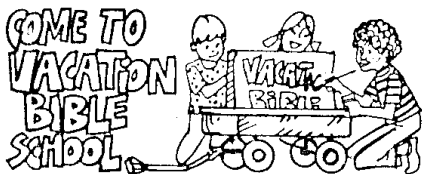

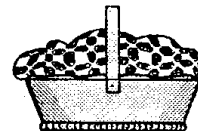

On April 16th, the Youth Group enjoyed volleyball and a salad supper. Remember, the youth are still collecting cans for the convention!



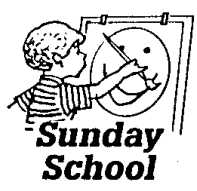

TRUSTEES PLANNING...

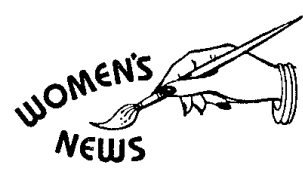

COME, HOLY SPIRIT!

In the month of May, we will celebrate the Confirmation of two of our young people, Gregg Harris and Joel Scheiwe, and we will celebrate the Festival of Pentecost. Our faith in Jesus is the result of the Holy Spirit's work. "No one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit" (I Cor. 12:3). The Church of Jesus is also the product of the Spirit's work, as he brings people together in Jesus and makes them part of the body of Christ.

The Rite of Confirmation is not a new baptism; it is not a being "born again"; nor is it even a

means of grace. Confirmation is the opportunity to affirm the faith relationship with Jesus that was begun in Holy Baptism, by the power of the Spirit. In Baptism, the Spirit unites us with Jesus and makes us his person. Confirmation gives a person the opportunity to affirm that relationship, to confess his faith in Jesus, and to proclaim that he wants to continue to walk the path of life with God in Jesus Christ.

It is the Holy Spirit who enables us to continue to trust in Jesus, and to live as his person day by day. He empowers us through the Word of God, and through the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion. It is crucial that each Christian continues to grow in the Word and to draw on the blessings and power of the Sacraments. Then, each day is a Holy Spirit celebration as we live in the joy of our salvation.
