

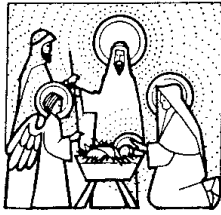

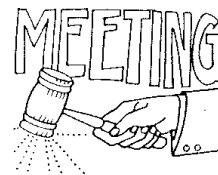
ADVENTURE SCHOOL BEGINS...

CONCORDIA APPROVES NEW HYMNAL...



A resolution was passed at the November Voters Meeting to purchase and use the hymnal, Lutheran Worship, which the Missouri Synod printed in 1982. This hymnal will be used as

Concordia's primary book of worship, replacing The Lutheran Hymnal.

The 150 hymnals that are needed will be purchased by designated gifts given for that purpose by individuals and groups. The hymnals will not be ordered until those funds have been received.

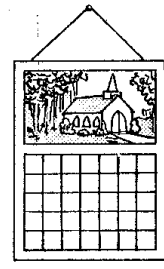

HE'S COMING!

The GIFT OF GRATITUDE-- Never forgetting to say "thank you" and never failing to mean it.

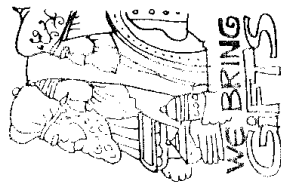
The GIFT OF ATTENTION-- When the other fellow speaks, listen attentively. If his words are directed to you personally meet his eye squarely.
