"Learning, Living, Sharing the Gospel"

Dear Concordia,

Two experiences draw together for my thoughts here. The first is our congregation's reading of Galatians throughout this month. I hope you're reading along with us, using Luther's 1535 Galatian commentary as a way to engage the text.

The second is our congregation's support of the Yampa Valley Men's Bible Study hosted here on Thursdays each week. We are studying and applying the wondrous OT teaching of Daniel. You are always invited and can join with us at any time.

How are these related? Both Daniel and Galatians proclaim the Kingdom of God. Both explore the stunning beauty of the King – Jesus – and how to enter His Kingdom, enjoy its riches, proclaim its truth, embody its teaching, demonstrate its reality, and inherit its promises. Both recognize the Kingdom of God as the true Empire that stands against all other empires, allegiances, lords and kings, presidents and prime ministers, bureaucrats and tyrants.

This is the Gospel of the King and His Kingdom!

Interestingly, Paul marvels that the Galatians can even consider another so-called "gospel." Last Sunday, I asked if there even is another gospel than the Gospel of King Jesus. While the answer should be "no," the truth is that there are other gospels running amok in the world today, even in North America.

I offered two examples. First, there is the widely proclaimed and much-love "gospel of libertinism." The main message of this fake gospel is, "You are welcome in God's kingdom, and you don't have to change." At the heart of this gospel, from which many versions take form, is placing worldly and cultural desires over and above the Word of God. Not much of a gospel!

Secondly, there is the "gospel of legalism." The main message here is, "You are not welcome in the kingdom unless you change." At the heart of this gospel is placing the strength and capabilities of the human being over and above the Word of God. Again, not much of a gospel!

From this perspective, what is the Gospel? The Gospel of the Kingdom announces, "I welcome you into My Kingdom, and as a result, you will be changed." At the heart of this Gospel is the work of Jesus the Christ as our Redeemer and Savior linked to the teaching of Jesus the Christ our Master and Teacher. We are brought into the Kingdom by grace; we are sustained in the Kingdom through the Spirit working through Word and Sacrament in the congregation.

In truth, this is the purpose of Confirmation, learning and applying the work of God in and through Baptism. At the end of this month, when we gather on October 29th, I will introduce the seven confirmands to you. They are discovering their place in the Kingdom of Jesus. I hope you'll get to know them, pray for them, and, as you can, encourage them in their faith-journey.
